## **Speaker Biographies:**

### **Blair M. Eig, M.D., M.B.A., M.A.**

Blair M. Eig, M.D. has been the Senior Vice President for Medical Affairs and Chief Medical Officer at Holy Cross Hospital since 2001 following 14 years in private pediatric practice in Silver Spring, MD. He is a former president of the medical staff at Children's Hospital, former president of the Montgomery-Prince George's Pediatric Society and long-time co-chair of the Laboratory Advisory Committee for the State of Maryland.

Blair received a Bachelor's Degree in Biology and Biochemistry and a Master's Degree in Biochemistry from Brandeis University, a Medical Degree from Harvard Medical School and a Masters in Business Administration from American University. He did his residency in pediatrics at Children's National Medical Center in Washington, DC, where he also spent one year as chief resident.

### **Ingrid Connerney, DrPH, MPH, RN**

Dr. Connerney is the Senior Director of Safety, Quality, and Clinical Effectiveness at the University of Maryland Medical Center. She is an assistant Professor at the University of Maryland School of Medicine, and an Associate Professor at the University of Maryland School of Nursing. Dr Connerney was educated in Denmark as a nurse, and has a master and doctoral degree from the Mailman School of Public Health at Columbia University School in New York.

Dr. Connerney is responsible for patient safety and quality programs for 38,000 admissions, 170,000 clinic visits, and 66,000 Emergency Room visits yearly. She successfully coordinated University of Maryland Medical Center's Leapfrog application leading to Leapfrog recognition for being among top U.S. hospitals for Quality and Safety 5 years in a row. She is certified as a Lean Six Sigma Black Belt, and has presented on quality improvement and safety culture at national and regional conferences.
